GENERAL INFORMATION

The 19th World Sanskrit Conference (WSC) will be held in **Kathmandu, Nepal**, from the **17th to the 21st of December, 2024**. The conference will adhere to the standard modus operandi followed by the preceding conferences: there shall be 28 thematic sections, and each section will have a number of experts (committee members), who will be in charge of evaluating and promoting individual papers for presentation at the conference and nominating the session chairs. Additionally, there will be special panels that may or may not be part of the regular sections.

CALL FOR INDIVIDUAL PAPERS (EXTENDED DEADLINE)

WSC2024 invites individual papers to be presented in one of the **28 thematic sections**. Interested scholars are welcome to submit the abstract through the conference website at <u>www.nepalworldsanskrit.org</u>. In case of a technical difficulty, we suggest that the abstracts be mailed to the conference secretariat at: <u>info@nepalworldsanskrit.org</u> and <u>worldsanskrit2024@gmail.com</u>.

The deadline for individual abstracts has been extended to 1 April 2024, and the special panel acceptance notification will be provided by the end of March.

Each paper will be allotted a time of 20 minutes, with an additional 10 minutes for discussion. Papers may be delivered in English or Sanskrit. We encourage scholars who are presenting a paper in Sanskrit to provide a summary in English.

The International Association for Sanskrit Studies (IASS) is the governing body that oversees the organization of the triennial World Sanskrit Conferences. For this reason, the conference registration is an occasion, for old members, to renew their membership, and for newcomers to gain membership of the IASS. Therefore, the WSC24 registration fees are inclusive of a three-year membership of the IASS, which is priced at 72\$ for regular members and 50\$ for students.
